VACCINATION PROTOCOL

We follow Neotech's Vaccination Protocol. Please read more about their products on their website: <https://neotechvaccines.com/>

The highlighted portions are the vaccinations that you will be responsible for taking care of at the vet clinic of your choosing after bringing your puppy home:

- 35 days (5 weeks) of age
NEOPAR® (Canine Parvovirus Vaccine)
- 42 days (6 weeks) of age
NEOVAC® DA2 (Canine Distemper-Adenovirus Type 2 Vaccine)
- 49 days (7 weeks) of age
NEOPAR® (Canine Parvovirus Vaccine)
- 56 days (8 weeks) of age
NEOVAC® DA2 (Canine Distemper-Adenovirus Type 2 Vaccine)
- 70 days (10 weeks) of age
NEOPAR® (Canine Parvovirus Vaccine)
NEOVAC® DA2 (Canine Distemper-Adenovirus Type 2 Vaccine)
***Your vet will likely administer a DA2PP vaccination at this age, in place of the Neopar and Neovac**
- 98 days (14 weeks) of age
NEOPAR® (Canine Parvovirus Vaccine)
NEOVAC® DA2 (Canine Distemper-Adenovirus Type 2 Vaccine)
***Your vet will likely administer another DA2PP vaccination at this age, in place of the Neopar and Neovac**
***Administer Rabies vaccine according to state law**

A note on our vaccination protocol:

Please do not let your vet convince you that your puppy needs to "restart" his vaccination series.

We purchase our vaccines from Revival Animal Health and have them overnighted on ice. We store them at the appropriate temperature and observe expiration dates. We administer each vaccination properly and with great scrutiny. **Please be your puppy's advocate.** The only vaccination that is required by law to be administered by a veterinarian is the Rabies vaccination. Please start your puppy's vaccination schedule at the appropriate time according to the schedule above.
